

NANANU-I-RA

- **Golden Dream**
This is a beautiful dive site, suitable for any certification level. Lots of soft corals, sea fans and vibrantly coloured hard corals, teeming with fish life. Max depth: 18m.
- **Shark Alley**
In the right tide, you can often find sharks - white tip, black tip, grey reef – circling the end of the point. Sometimes there's a turtle on the reef heading out to the point, but there's beautiful corals to admire on the safety stop. With its depth and the currents that bring the sharks in, this is only for Advanced divers. Max depth: 24m.
- **Turning Point**
Three big bommies provide a continuous snake like course, hence the name 'Turning Point'. Big swim-through at 18m, colourful Antheas, red bass and puffer fish. Soft corals abound on one end where the current runs. Max depth: 22m

LEVUKA

- **Levuka Passage (Pipeline)**
A narrow passage, strong currents and deep. Schooling fish by the thousands, giant groupers, eagle and manta rays, barracuda, trevally, White tips, grey reef and bull sharks are regularly seen as well as occasional tiger shark sightings. Advance divers only. Max depth: 30m.
- **Levuka Pier**
The site for the connoisseur! The strangest critters you can find... Ghost pipefish, decorator crab, Frogfish, needlefish... for divers with eyes for the most beautiful. Suitable for all levels. Max depth: 12m.

SAVUSAVU

- **Golden Nuggets**
An easy boat ride from Savusavu, this Bay dive is abundant in yellow soft corals, anthias, garden eels, lion fish, scorpion fish, scorpion leaf fish, anemone fish, circular clams and garden eels. You also have the chance to get your teeth cleaned by resident cleaner shrimp! Suitable for all levels. Max depth: 20m.
- **Dreadlocks**
A Savusavu Bay dive with two coral heads covered in soft corals with a host of small fish, invertebrate and macro-life. Intermediate level. Max depth: 18m
- **Marshmallows**
A journey of discovery awaits you on this Savusavu Bay dive featuring impressive stag horn corals, cushion stars, moray eels, nudibranchs, popcorn shrimp on adhesive anemones, cleaner shrimp, scorpion leaf fish and groupers. This used to be a great dive site. Intermediate level. Max depth: 16m

TAVEUNI – MATEI

- **Pearly Point**
Very easy dive with pinnacles and lots of hard corals, such as stag horn, elk horn, table and plate corals. It's a great place to see octopus, cod, clams and clouds of fusiliers. Max depth 12m.

TAVEUNI – WAIRIKI

- **The Great White Wall**
This is rated by many dive enthusiasts as one of the best dive sites on the planet. The site hosts a stunning vertical wall covered in white Dendronephthya soft corals which drops to over 100 meters (300 feet). This site includes large lava tubes, schools of anthias, and larger pelagics cruising along the drop-off. Suitable for all levels (depending on the current). Max depth 30m (depending on experience).
- **Purple Wall**
This wall dive (to about 50m) on the fringing reef is a blast of purple soft corals, inundated with more fish than you can throw a stick at. Don't forget to keep a look out into the blue, as you never know what might come gliding past. Max depth 26m. Suitable for all levels.
- **Rainbow Reef**
Visually stunning dive with thousands of colourful fish and corals passing before your eyes like a cinema screen as you drift by in the current. This is one site you don't want to miss. Don't forget to breathe!
